

- OverDrive*- A downloadable audiobook and eBook service offered by the Westchester Library System
- Freading*- A downloadable eBook service offered by the Westchester Library System
- Freegal*- A downloadable music service that the Westchester Library System subscribes to. All you need to access the service is your Westchester Library card.
- Comics Plus: Library Edition – The new digital revolution bringing thousands of digital graphic novels and comics are only a click away!
- TumbleBooks- An online collection of animated, talking picture books, reading comprehension quizzes, educational games and teacher resources for libraries.
- OneClickDigital*- A collection of approximately 4,000 audiobooks for unlimited and instant download to your MP3 player or iPod/
- Total BooX – Total BooX lets WLS patrons read, share and discover books with no restrictions, no waiting lists and no tokens. (please note Total Boox is in beta)
- Project Gutenberg- A collection of free eBooks.
- Google Books- Search and preview millions of books from libraries and publishers worldwide using Google Book Search. Discover a new favorite or unearth an old classic.
- Free Music Archive- The Free Music Archive provides free, high-quality, music in a wide range of genres. The content of Free Music Archive is used under various creative commons licenses. The New York State Music Fund provided initial funding for FMA. FMA seeks to maintain a high-quality resource through the use of selected curators who approve or deny all submissions to the collection.

TIPS for locating digital resources in the Westchester Library System Catalog

1. When looking for a digital resources, scan your results lists for the icon that indicates format type.
2. You can filter your search results (left-hand bar) in several helpful ways (see left-hand column of results screen) including electronic format. Remember to select “include” or “exclude” when you apply the filters.
3. Remember: Use the top bar to limit your search terms to fields such as author, title and subject.
