Henry's future isn't looking too promising, either. His girlfriend dumped him. The bookstore is slipping away. And his family is breaking apart.

As Henry and Rachel work side by side—surrounded by books, watching love stories unfold, exchanging letters between the pages—they find hope in each

other. Because life may be uncontrollable, even unbearable sometimes. But it's possible that words, and love, and second chances are enough.
